Passing Minimum – Post Graduate and M.Phil. Courses

For a pass in each theory and practical paper, a student should secure a minimum of 45% marks in the Terminal Examination and a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate (i.e., internal and terminal marks put together).

Conduct of Re-Tests for Students

Re-tests for the students will be conducted only for those

- (1) who represent the College or Department in any of the following
 - (a) NCC
 - (b) Inter-collegiate NSS Programmes
 - (c) University/ Zone/ District/ State level sports events
- (2) who have a real background of sickness on the dates of assessment test (should produce medical certificate) and
- (3) who are absent to the tests for genuine reasons.

Those who come under the category (1), have to intimate the Dean - Students' Service and Internal Examination Cell well in advance with the permission letter duly signed by the corresponding Head of the Department and the staff in-charge of the events.

Those who come under the categories (2) and (3), have to inform their respective class teachers/ Head of the Departments. They may write re-test, only after getting permission from their Head of the Department and Dean - Students Service.

The students have to write the internal assessment test, for which they do not appear on the dates fixed by the Dean – internal.

Students who fail to score the required minimum marks in the assessment test will not be allowed for re-tests.
