

I. CURRICULAR ASPECTS

An effective curriculum is the means to achieve the aims of education. Therefore, the importance and the impact of curricular aspect in any educational institution cannot be overstated. Developing an appropriate and need based curricula to suit the professional and personal needs of the students is the primary task of higher education.

On the basis of the feedback given by the stakeholders, major revision of syllabus was done for the third year UG programmes. The departments were advised to introduce subjects relevant to the present context and to meet the global needs.

- The ratio between the Internal and External marks for all the PG programmes was revised as 40:60, new subject codes were given to all the courses.
- Board of Studies Meeting was held on 10.07.2019 to finalise the syllabus of I year UG programmes of 1) B.Voc. Food Safety and Quality Management and 2) B.Sc. Physical Education.
- Board of Studies Meeting was held on 21.09.2019 to finalise the syllabus of III year UG programmes of 1) Tamil, 2) English, 3) Maths, 4) Economics, 5) Computer Science and 6) Zoology.
- Board of Studies Meeting was held on 29.02.2020 to finalise the syllabus of III year UG programmes of 1) History, 2) BBA, 3) Commerce, 4) Physics, 5) Chemistry, 6) Botany, 7) Microbiology, 8) BCA & MCA, 9) B.Voc. Food Safety and Quality and Management, 10) B.Voc. Renewable Energy, 11) B.Sc. Physical Education and 12) NCC-NME.
- Academic Council Meeting was held on 18.10.2019 to approve the new / modified syllabus framed by the Board of Studies.
- ✤ Newly introduced 69 courses were approved.
- Modification done in 129 existing courses were approved.

- 141 courses of 50 programmes are focusing on employability / entrepreneurship / skill development.
- Resolved to award extra credits of 2, 4 and 6 to the students who successfully complete NPTEL course with the duration of 4, 8 and 12 weeks respectively.
- Introduced internship as an optional one for the PG students at the end of the second semester and to award an extra credit of 3 to the students who complete the Internship for a minimum period of thirty working days.
- Approved the introduction of *Gandhian Thoughts* as an optional Self-Learning Subject in the fourth semester of all UG programmes from the academic year 2019-2020 and to award an extra credit of 5 to students who complete the course successfully.

II. TEACHING, LEARNING, AND EVALUATION

The institution initiates innovative methods of teaching, learning and evaluation system to make learning a process of construction of knowledge. The teaching and the non-teaching faculties are the backbone of the institution. Teachers of our institution do not simply deliver lectures on lessons but also they carve out the niche for themselves and continue to inspire and motivate the young minds. The primary aim of the college is to encourage students to develop a spirit of independent thinking and intensive and extensive reading and learning.

1. Staff strength

The total faculty strength of our institution during the academic year 2019-2020 was 200, which includes 120 Government Aided and 80 self-financing faculties. Among 200 staff members, 101 Aided and 29 Self-Financed staff are having Ph.D. degree. Among 80 Self-financed staff members 25 staff members are with NET / SET qualification and 23 staff members are with Ph.D. qualification.

2. Ph.D. Awardees

Even though the sacred duty of the college is to preserve the knowledge already acquired in the past, it exists chiefly to extend the boundaries of knowledge. Research work in every branch of learning is the sine qua non of a college. Our professors constantly engage themselves in research works and contribute something new and valuable to the society. Ten departments of our college offer full-time and part-time research programmes to scholars, faculty of our college and to the teachers of other institutions. Two of our faculty members were awarded the prestigious Doctoral Degree (Ph.D.) for their contribution to their respective chosen fields of knowledge in this academic year alone. Central Library

The college has a well-equipped, fully automated library with the stateof-the art facilities. There are more than 107245 books and 170 periodicals on various subjects. In this academic year 2019-20, 1634 books are added to the collection to meet the text books need of our students. It is fully automated with Library Management Software and lending facility equipped with barcode technology.

Our Library has renewed the membership of DELNET – Developing Library Network in this year also. As a member, we are receiving books, journal articles, e-journal articles, CDs etc., which are available in Libraries all over India through inter library loan facility for a specified period of time.

Our Library is a member of American Information Resource Centre, Chennai. Our college library is provided with five AIRC library cards and we can lend 4 books, 2 periodicals and One CD per library card. The members can select books for lending from online catalogue, which is available in American Consulate Chennai website, and the books will be sent by AIRC through courier.

The library is member in Inflibnet (Shodhsindhu) which covers more than 5000 on-line journal and 10280 e-books. Individual passwords are provided for students and staff members.

All the students and staff are provided with ID cards with barcode which ensures easy accessibility and book issue procedure.

To cater the needs of the visually challenged students, our library has a collection of 65 audio CDs and 32 braille books in various subjects. The audio collection includes self-confident topics, competitive examination books etc., which made available for the students at any time. Two 2TB external hard disks are purchased to store 1200 audio books.

Anti-Plagiarism Checker

Anti-Plagiarism Tool URKUND helps to check the document against the e-resources, published e-books and thesis or other documents which is submitted earlier in Urkund database. All the faculty members and Scholars of our college those who are involved in research and paper publication can use this for checking plagiarism.

E-Gate

The introduction of barcode scanner is quite suitable for circulation job of library and in monitoring the entry and exit of the library users. This system replaced the manual user entry - register method.

Extension Activities

Library Club has been formed for developing various skills of students and performing extension activities. Nearly 50 students from various departments enrolled as library club members. Numerous skill developments have been organized for the club members.

Reader Review Forum
