Our College Library is a member of DELNET – Developing Library Network. As a member, we are receiving books and journal article, e-journal articles, CDs etc. which are available in all over Indian Libraries through inter library loan for a period of time. Availability of books is known by means of searching through delnet database. As Our College Library is a member of American Information Resource Centre, Chennai, our college user community is benefited by means of getting all kinds of resources.

Our College subscribes J-Gate online database – Social and Management sciences for the management students. The database consists of e-articles in Social and Management sciences related disciplines.
