I. CURRICULAR ASPECTS

An effective curriculum is the means to achieve the aims of education. Therefore, the importance and the impact of curricular aspect in any educational institution cannot be overstated. Developing an appropriate and need based curricula to suit the professional and personal needs of the students is the primary task of higher education.

The institution makes sincere efforts to cater and fulfill the needs of the society by contributing in its own way to the enrichment of the curriculum. A well-planned and well-executed curriculum contributes towards the achievement of educational aims and development of desirable behavior patterns. The curriculum does not confine the teachers and the taught to mere completion of prescribed syllabus. It is not limited to theoretical aspects alone, but it should also be practical and pragmatic to the real life.

On the basis of the feedback given by the stakeholders, major **revision of syllabus was done for the third year UG and a Common Self-learning subject “Human Rights” was introduced for the second year UG students in the fourth semester.** To update the syllabi for the third year UG courses and the Self-learning subject, Board of Studies Meetings were conducted in this academic year. The departments were advised to introduce subjects relevant to the present context and to meet the global needs.

II. TEACHING, LEARNING, AND EVALUATION

The teaching and the non-teaching faculties are the backbone of the institution. Teachers of our institution do not simply deliver lectures on lessons but also they carve out the niche for themselves and continue to inspire and motivate the young minds. The primary aim of the college is to encourage students to develop a spirit of independent thinking and intensive and extensive reading and learning. The dedicated team of teachers continuously suggests and makes students read books and to be sound in what they learn. The knowledge they acquire in their respective subjects is to attain and scale new heights in their academic endeavors and achieve special grades in their academic life.

1. Staff strength

The total faculty strength of our institution during the academic year 2016-2017 was 200, which includes 108 Government Aided and 92 self-financing faculties. Among 200 staff members, 79 Aided staff and 26 Self Finance staff are with Ph.D.

Even though the sacred duty of the college is to preserve the knowledge already acquired in the past, it exists chiefly to extend the boundaries of knowledge. IV. INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

Our Library has a collection of 102119 books and 162 periodicals. In the academic year 2016-17, nearly 1018 books are added to the collection to meet the text books need of our students.

In our Library Digital section old computers were replaced with new systems and a server with the storage capacity of 2GB RAM for E-Resource Management is also made available for scholars' access.

Institutional knowledge Repository – IKR has been created in our library by means of scanning our valuable books, question banks and other necessary documents for dissemination of resources in e-format.

UGC-Infonet e-resource is the most highly required one to all academicians. Our College has become a member of UGC-Infonet NLIST consortium and N-LIST provides access to all kinds of resources which include more than 2100 e-journals and 51000 e-books of offering individual user ids and passwords.

Our College Library is a member of DELNET – Developing Library Network. As a member, our college receives books and journal article, e-journal articles, CDs etc. which are available in Libraries all over India through inter library loan for a period of time. Availability of books is known by means of searching through Delnet database. As Our College Library is a member of American Information Resource Centre, Chennai, our college user community is benefited by means of getting all kinds of resources.

Green Stone Digital Library Scheme

GSDL software offers a e-resource management system for storing, arranging and disseminating the e-resource through intranet. At present, six systems are connected with server for e-resource dissemination.

E-Document Delivery Service

Our library delivers e-documents to our staff and students on request which is downloaded through Inter Library loan from other libraries.

Audio Library

To cater to the needs of the visually challenged students, our library has a collection of 65 audio CDs. The audio collection includes books on self-development topics, competitive examination etc., which are made available for the students at any time.

Ready Reference Desk

This service offers the hard and soft copies of Newspapers' Special columns like **Know Your English, News on Science & Technology** and **Employment Opportunities etc.**, for knowledge updation.

Building Renovation

The following construction works were undertaken on the campus to improve the existing facilities

- 1) Foundation stone for the construction of Multi-purpose Hall at an estimate of ₹ 1,37,00,000/- was laid on 17th August, 2016.
- 2) Our institution was recognized as Pratan Manthri Kaushal Kendra and for conducting training programmes for the unemployed youth, new class rooms were constructed at a cost of ₹ 75,30,412/-.
- 3) For conducting UGC sponsored B.Voc. programme on **Environmental Assessment and Remediation** an existing building was renovated into class rooms and laboratory at an estimate of ₹ 20,11,130/-.
- 4) An amount of ₹ 16,23,728/- was spent on constructing additional toilets in the boys hostel. New closets and glazed tiles were fixed in the toilets.

Revenue Generation

The College gets revenue from the GYM, Swimming Pool and Indoor Stadium open to the public. This year 155 men regularly utilized the GYM, 85 utilized the resources in Indoor stadium and nearly 13,500 used the swimming pool.
