26. Increase in the infrastructural facilities:

- ➤ An additional storey has been erected with a few class rooms, a laboratory and other necessary facilities on the first floor of KCSR Block to accommodate the students of the professional courses that come under AICTE.
- ➤ A new, modern, versatile steam-cooking unit at the cost of Rs.4,00,000/-has been installed in our college boys hostel.
- An amount of Rs.9,00,000/- has been spent for the construction of a concrete Basket-Ball court with flood-light facilities in our college play-ground.

- ➤ One more new bus at a cost of Rs.14 lakhs has been purchased for the conveyance of girl students coming from nearby areas.
- ➤ A Mini Van was purchased at the cost of Rs.1,41,600/- for the convenience of the staff members.
- As there is a gradual increase in the strength of the girl students in the hostel, the management has initiated the construction work of a new ladies' hostel at the cost of Rs.1.08 crores, funded jointly by UGC and our College Management. The construction work is in progress.
- ➤ To provide a separate premises for the professional courses that come under the AICTE, new classrooms and laboratories have been constructed on the first floor of KCSR Block by the Management at the cost of Rs.21,00,000/-.
- ➤ To provide high speed internet facility to all the departments, the management spent Rs.2,27,828/- in the last year.
- ➤ In order to ensure uninterrupted power supply, the management has spent Rs.2,67,408/- towards the fuel and maintenance cost of the power generator.
- ➤ To encourage students in sports activities, the management offered fee concession to the outstanding players in various games and sports and also incentives to the tune of Rs.99,157/-.
- ➤ Incentives worth Rs.1,04,799/- has been given to the Teaching and Non-Teaching staff of our college as a token of appreciation for their outstanding performances in the academic works.
- ➤ The college management has spent a sum of Rs.43,342/- for motivating research-related activities.

- ➤ The NCC cadets went on a rally in Virudhunagar on 06.08.2007 to create awareness on Malarial fever. They issued pamphlets on the precautions to be taken to avoid the spreading of the disease.
- An Anti Tobacco awareness meeting was held on 10.09.2007 to make the students aware of the menace of the use of tobacco.
- ➤ The NCC cadets did a noble service by assisting the government authorities when Pulse Polio Campaigns were conducted on 10.02.2008 and 12.02.2008 at various pockets of Virudhunagar.
- ➤ A rally was conducted on 01.08.2007 to create awareness among the public on chikungunya, a viral fever that was spreading rapidly in Virudhunagar district. The rally enrooted the busy streets of Virudhunagar and came to halt at Desabandhu Maidan.
- ➤ A free eye check-up camp was conducted on 22.08.2007 in collaboration with Aravind Eye Hospital, Madurai. 350 students and teachers attended the camp and were benefitted.

- ➤ A cycle rally to Courtallam was conducted on 01,02,03-09-2007 by the NSS and NCC units of the college to create awareness on Environmental Protection. The students took placards containing slogans stressing the need for protecting our environmental. The rally covered a distance of 300 kilometers.
- ➤ An AIDS awareness rally was conducted on 01.12.2007 by the NCC units and Y's Men Club of Virudhunagar. The students propagated safety measures to be taken to guard oneself from the killer diseases.

37. Placement services provided to students:

38. Development programmes for non-teaching staff

Modernization becomes inevitable in executing office work. The traditional system of paper work has to be discouraged if the office has to go green and be efficient and effective. 39. Best practices of the Institution

- ➤ The management has appointed sufficient number of staff in permanent vacancies which remained vacant and not filled by the Government. It has incurred an additional expenditure of Rs.9,69,699.
- The Placement Cell has been rendering valuable services to the students for making them employable. A Placement officer has been appointed to this purpose. Students are given training in communication skills, interview techniques, aptitude, goal setting and soft skill. It is to be noted here that these services are offered to the students without charging anything from them.
- ➤ The Management has sanctioned Rs. 29,000/- towards fee concession and Mess concession in this academic year.
- > The teaching and non-teaching staff members who have rendered valuable services and attained academic excellences are honoured with cash incentives and mementos.
- ➤ To create interest in sports and games welcome sports are conducted for the freshers in the beginning of the academic year.
- A blood donors club is functioning as a wing of Youth Red Cross unit of the college. The club has arranged six mass blood donation camps and helped in saving the lives of hundreds of patients who were in need of blood.
- > Special trainings were given by the Physical Education Department to the students who aspire for uniform services.
- ➤ The Youth Red Cross unit of the college arranged for a four wheeler driving classes by joining hands with Abirami Driving School, Virudhunagar. 120 students participated in the driving classes and were issued permanent driving license.

➤ Various programmes were arranged by Women Empowerment Cell to educate the girl students on cleanliness and hygiene, tapping of the talents of women, and to train the students to stand on their own legs.
