



Report on the Summative Examinations, April 2018

A report on the Summative Examinations under the Autonomy Stream, held in the month of April 2018, submitted to the Principal.

Pre – Exam Preparations

A total number of 345 current exam question papers & 322 arrear exam question papers were set by 296 examiners. All the questions papers were set by teachers with not less than 6 years of teaching experience. We are happy to inform that almost all the teachers who were offered the question setting accepted gladly and completed the assignment within the time frame.

Examinations

The Summative Examinations commenced on April 23rd, 2018 and ended on May 19th, 2018. A total number of 3710 students of U.G, P.G, Certificate Course, PG Diploma and M. Phil Courses appeared for the examinations. During the course of examinations, a total number of 152 students(420 scripts) were absent in the 44 sessions of examinations. We regret to inform that 10 students indulged in malpractices during the examinations. The list of students indulged in malpractices and the absentees list are enclosed.

A total number of 27,568 answer scripts (20,256 current exams, 1,755 arrear exams and 4,412 practical exams, 997 Part V exams, 148 OMR scripts) were evaluated. Answer scripts of ten students, who indulged in malpractices, were not valued and their results withheld. In total 25,675 scripts out of 27,568 scripts passed the examinations. The overall pass percentage is 93.13%.

We are proud to place on record that we have conducted all the semester examination's theory papers using OMR (Optical Mark Recognition) statements. We have also used OMR foil cards for our practical examinations (both internal & external). The usage of OMR machine in our Controller of Examinations office was very helpful in bringing out the results in a more effective manner and in a short duration.


All the answer scripts were given OMR tearing on the same day of examination by a team of dedicated teachers, which enabled us to expedite the valuations. We place on record our sincere thanks and gratitude to our College staff members involved in this task.

Evaluation

A total number of 131 external examiners were appointed to carry out the evaluation work. The examiners were from Thoothukudi, Madurai, Thirumangalam, Sivagangai, Paramakudi, Poondi, Ramanad, Rajapalayam, Melur, Sivakasi, Sattur, Aruppukottai and Virudhunagar. The Central Valuation was started on April 30th, 2018 and was over on 21st May, 2018 (18 days). The OMR mark and data entries were verified by our teachers, which helped for effective valuation. In this regard, we thank them for their noble service. One Student applied for photocopying and 54 numbers of students (80 scripts) applied for revaluation. 18 scripts were declared as pass and 4 scripts got marks enhanced in the revaluation. Supplementary Examinations were conducted for the UG, PG out-going students who got 1 or 2 arrears in the final semester only. 103 Students appeared for the supplementary exams. 101 Students cleared the papers. Totally 125 scripts were valued in this examination and 123 scripts were declared as pass. The examiners were given a pre-structured questionnaire to get their feedback. The following are some of the important suggestions given by the examiners:

1. Most of the students do not specify the question numbers and also the sub division number. The examiners asked us to insist the students to write the **Questions Numbers & Sub Divisions correctly**.
2. Slow learners may be identified and given extra coaching.
3. Key and Scheme of valuation may be prepared by the course teacher.

Awards Committee Meeting was conducted on 04.06.2018 and the results were published in our College official website and also our college apps VHNSNC on 06.06.2018. The revaluation results were published on 04.07.2018. In overall, 92.82 % of UG scripts, 94.39 % of PG scripts, 95.76 % of Certificate Course scripts, 98.01 % of Diploma course scripts were declared as pass.
