Sami, Assistant Professor in Chemistry is the Co-ordinator of the programme. Under the HEPSN Scheme the following activities were carried out in the academic year 2010 - 2011.

- I. To encourage the differently - abled students to appear for the Bank Examinations, a series of classes were conducted in the months of August and September 2010, highlighting the pattern of question asked in the Bank Examinations and methods to prepare for them. Dr.R.Vairamuthuvel, Associate Professor in Commerce handled the sessions. Fifteen students participated in the classes. To prepare the candidates for the bank examinations books were distributed to the students at free of cost.
- II. Three students enthusiastically participated in the "Inter - collegiate competitions for Differently Abled Students" organised by Leo Club of Sivakasi at Sri Kaliswari College, Sivakasi on 24.08.2010. Our students Mr. R. Jeyaperumal and Mr. V. Ramesh lifted prizes in Public Speaking and Tongue Twister competitions.
- III. Special coaching classes for the Bank examinations were conducted for the differently - abled students in association with the Old Boys Association of our college during January 2011. Dr.R.Vairamuthuvel, Associate Professor in Commerce, Dr.R.Selvam, Associate Professor in English, Mr.G.Senthil, Assistant Professor in Commerce and Mr.R.Ayyamperumal, Assistant Professor in Business Administration handled classes. Ten of our students actively participated in the programme.
- IV. In order to update the computer knowledge of the differently abled persons, a course on "Microsoft Office and Internet" was organised during March 2011. The programme was conducted by the Department of Computer Science. Mrs.J.Nagasudha and Mrs.T.Krishnaveni served as subject experts. The programme consisted of both theories as well as hands on training sessions. Totally eight sessions were given to the students.

- V. A small garden in front of our college main library was established and maintained under this scheme. Saplings of flowering trees, bonsai and ornamental flowering plants were planted. The maintenance of this garden serves as a pass time activities for the differently - abled students and also injects a sense of confidence in them.
- VI. Information regarding various aids available from the Government for the differently - abled persons were passed on to the students with the help of the District Social Welfare Officer, Virudhunagar. This year our students Mr.K.Lakshmanakumar and Y.Thangaraj received "Battery operated Motor Fixed Three Wheeler" from the District authorities. Twelve of our students received 3000/- each as Welfare Scholarship from the Commission for the differently - abled.
- VII. An Intercollegiate programme for the differently - abled students was conducted in view of the "World Day for the Differently - abled" on 16th March 2011. Seventy five students from ten different colleges actively participated in this programme. Competitions such as Elocution, Tongue twister, Cross word puzzle, Word games and Drawing competitions were conducted. Dr.Sundara Avudaiappan, Programme Executive, All India Radio, Madurai and leading Tamil Orator addressed the students on the title "Sky is our Limit". He also distributed prizes to the winners of the competitions and mementoes to all the participants. Self development books were also given to the participants.

### ***Fine Arts Club***

To bring out the innate talents of the students in creative writing, eloquence, painting, dance, music, etc. Fine Arts Club is functioning in the college in a very effective manner. A RHYTHM, COLLEGE ORCHESTRA, A PART OF FINE ARTS CLUB IS performing well under the leadership of Dr R.Priyakumar, Assistant Professor in English. It has given entertainment to our students and the public in all our college programs including the special camps organised by NSS.

In this academic year the Fine Arts Club and Old Boys Association joined together and conducted inter departmental cultural competitions. The Department of English won the first prize.

Annappoorani Ramiah Memorial Tamil Elocution Competition was conducted at the inter university level. Our students lifted the first prize in the competition.

In the Elocution Competition conducted by Madurai Theiva Neri Kazhagam and Rajapalayam Thiruvalluvar Manram, our students bagged first prizes. To add one more feather to the cap, the students won second prize in the elocution competition conducted by Pahutharivalar Kazhagam at the state level.
